Sub:- ACCOUNTS - WDA - Release of Medical Advance to Sri S. Raghuram, Jr. Asst for undergoing by pass surgery - Ratification - Reg.

AGENDA NOTE

Sri S. Raghuram, Jr. Asst in his letter dt. 7.7.2000 has submitted that as per the advise of the Doctor at Care Hospital, Visakhapatnam he is undergoing coronary Artery by pass grafting (CABG) surgery at Medicity Centre, Hyderabad during the month of July, 2000 and hence requested to grant medical advance as per rules to meet the expenditure. He enclosed the advise of the Care Hospital in this regard.

The WDA employees are being paid medical allowance equal to 1 month basic pay payable in 4 quarterly instalments and hence the medical claims are not being considered as ^{per} Government rules.

As per G.O.Ms.No.161 dt. 5.5.2000 read with G.O.Ms.No.86 dt. 1.6.92 and G.O.Ms.No.373 HM & FW dt. 5.10.95 the Government employees are eligible for sanction of medical advance upto Rs.75,000/- towards the following ailments.

- a) Acute myocardial infraction and coronary artery disease (cardiology Department).
- b) Acute renal failure (Nephrology Department)
- c) Severe cases of Head and Spinal injury (Neuro-surgery Dept)
- d) Cases of Coma (Neurology Department).

As per G.O.Ms.No.38 dt. 23.1.96, the Medicity Centre, Hyderabad where he is going to undergo by pass surgery is the recognised hospital for re-imburement of expenditure towards coronary Artery diseases.

In case of treatment in the recognised private hospitals there will be a cut of 20% on the eligible amount vide G.O.Ms.No.175 dt. 22.5.97.

In view of all the above the request of Sri S.Raghuram, Jr.Asst to change his option and for release of medical advance as per Government rules i.e., 60,000/- after deducting 20% from Rs.75,000/- has been considered and payment made towards advance on 1.8.2000. He will henceforth be covered only as per the Government rules in force and will not receive the medical allowance (one month basic pay per year) in vogue in WUDA.

The matter is placed before the WUDA Board for its ratification.

VUDA Resolution No. 572, dt.9-8-2000

Resolved to ratify the action in having released Rs.60,000/- to Sri S.Raghuram, J.A., VUDA for undergoing bypass operation and also to receive medical allowance as per Govt. rules hence forth.
