Agenda Note

VUDA is recovering 0.25% from gross bills of the contractors and remitting the same to National Academy of Construction (NAC), Hyderabad as per the Govt. directions in G.O. Ms. No: 61 TR&B (R-III) Dept, dated: 11-04-2000. Further, in accordance with the directions of the Govt. in G.O. Ms. No: 159, TR&B (R-III) Dept, dated: 30-10-2004, the recovery has been effected and remitted in the ratio of 0.15% & 0.10% respectively to CM's Relief Fund and NAC respectively. So far an amount of Rs. 17,25,200/- has been remitted to NAC since 07/2001.

The VUDA has proposed to undertake Training Programme for the Unemployed Youth from the villages under the jurisdiction of VUDA as Welfare Scheme to uplift the poverty level and to generate employment in VMR Area. In this connection the Director, NAC was contacted and accordingly the Director NAC visited Visakhapatnam on 04-10-05. The following proposals have been furnished by the Director, NAC through their letter dated: 13-10-05.

- 1. To train initially in the trades of Masonry, Bar-bending and Plumbing on priority basis.
- To commence the training programme in Hyderabad for the 1st batch from 1st week of December, 05 initially for 30 candidates with an allocation of 10 candidates per trade.
- Simultaneously, a separate Training Centre will be established in Vizag in PWD Compound at Maharanipeta.

The details of Training Programme under consideration by CTTI, NAC are

- 1. Training is available at Hyderabad for the following six trades
 - a. Masonry
 - b. Bar-bending
 - c. Plumbing
 - d. Carpentry
 - e. Electrician
- 2. The total fee for the training programme is Rs. 11,000/
 - a. Training Period 3 months
 - b. Boarding & mess inclusive in the package
 - c. Tools box worth approx Rs. 2,000/- stipend @ Rs. 200/- per month for the three months training period and other work shop items such as shoes, apron, helmet etc., of worth Rs. 600/- will be provided to the technician at free of cost in the above training programme.
- 3. NAC will also provide guaranteed placement assistance for the trainee on enrolment by paying extra amount of Rs. 1,000/- per head.

4. Qualifications & Age limit for the candidates

Age Limit between 18 years to 35 years

Since, VUDA has taken up the Beach Road widening Project, it is proposed to take up the Training Programme for the Unemployed Youth from Fishermen Community in the first batch. Accordingly paper notification issued in daily news papers on 20th October, 05 inviting applications from the candidates.

It is also decided to stop the further remittance of Building Association Fund at 0.10% payable to NAC so as to make utilization of the same for the training programme.

The matter is place before VUDA Board for approval of the proposal.
