
AGENDA NOTE :

The Hon'ble Minister for Tribal Welfare and Deputy Director (TW), ITDA, Paderu requested the Vice Chairman, VUDA vide their letters (D.O. letter No.47/M/TW/2012, Dated 21-11-2012 and Rc.No.B2/229/2009, Dated: 20-11-2012 respectively to take up the construction of Hostel building for post matric girl students in Visakhapatnam city since there was an acute shortage of hostel facilities for ST girls students studying different courses in Visakhapatnam city. A copy of Type design of the proposed Hostel building was communicated by Superintending Engineer, Tribal Welfare. The Hon'ble Minister for Tribal Welfare further requested to improve the type design and build a model hostel since VUDA had a panel of good Architects.

The District Collector, Visakhapatnam has allotted Government land in Dwarakanagar area for construction of hostel building in Visakhapatnam.

Therefore it is proposed to take up the construction of Hostel building with an estimated cost of Rs 2.00 crores according to feasibility of site allotted by District Administration. The expenditure involved for the said project can be met from the ST component available in VUDA budget approved for the year 2012-13. At present Rs.2.66 Crs funds are available in the ST component. Further to construct the building with good design it is proposed to entrust the architectural design to one of the empanelled architects in VUDA.

Hence, the matter is placed before the VUDA Board for perusal and approval to take up "Construction of Hostel Building for Post Matric Students (Girls) at Visakhapatnam" with a Project Cost of Rs 2 00 Crore.
