It is to submit that during the Review Meeting on Development Activities conducted by Hon'bie Chief Minister of AP under Indizonma Bato in Skikalulam Diskitation 30-99-2012. Thereupon Vice Chairman, VUDA inspected the said road and observed lital it is an important road used by most of the residents in Narasannapeta Town connecting National Highway at Peddapeta junction and old Bus Stop junction. At present the road is in very bad shape and existing drains are choked and not functioning. Because of the above, pedestrians as well as vehicular traffic are facing much inconvenience and hence instructions were issued to submit necessary proposals for construction of GC Road and Drains to the said road.

in accordance with the above, estimate was prepared to lay VDF.

Cement Concrete and construction of CC Drains for the said road. The

length of the road is 1.60KM and width is 3.60Mts. The Storm Water Drain of

size 1-10" is proposed on both side of the road. The estimate is prepared

based on the common SOR for the year 2011-12 and circulars of Board of

Chief Engineer's and worked out to Rs. 125.00 Lobbs.

The Vice Chairman, VUDA accorded Administrative Sanction for Rs.125.00 Lakhs for the subject work and permitted to take up the same by way of 'e'-tenders.
