**Sub : VUDA -VSP-Estt.- Proposal for regularization of services of NMRs
- Reg.**

AGENDA NOTE :

It is submitted that as on date 65 NMRs/ 1 Contingent employee are working in VUDA in various wings. A statement showing the details of NMRs along with date from which working in VUDA, educational qualification & daily wages being paid is prepared and appended (statement -A). As seen from the statement, the NMRs are working since a long time and according to their date of birth they are overaged for any other recruitment in Government service.

Out of the above NMRs, 21 NMRs have completed 5 years of service as on 25-11-1993 and they are eligible for regularization. Further 14 NMRs have been deputed to VUDA from District Schedule Caste Cooperative Society on 1-2-1990 and are being continued in VUDA from then onwards. Recently the APAT, dt. 31-8-2012 has passed orders for 13 NMRs to once again examine the cases of the applicants by counting the services from their initial appointment in the District Schedule Caste Cooperative Society for fulfilling the condition that they have completed 5 years of service as on 25-11-1993. So the balance 30 NMRs and 1 contingent employee have not completed five years of service to the cutoff date i.e. on 25-11-1993. Some NMRs out of them are technically qualified with degrees like with B.E., B.Tech / Polytechnic and ITI qualification and are having considerable experience with VUDA works.

In the recent past the jurisdiction of VUDA has been extended by Government up to Srikakulam in northern side and Tuni to the southern side. But there is no fresh recruitment since 1985 except filling of backlog vacancies and appointments under compassionate grounds. In view of the number of retirements there is every need to increase the staffing strength of VUDA.

In this connection, it is submitted that the Government have regularized the services of 93 as LGS (Last Grade Servant) vide G.O.Ms No. 457, dt. 9-10-2002.

Since there are no sufficient vacancies to fill these NMRs against regular posts, proposals may be sent to the Government to regularize the services of balance 30 NMRs & 1 contingent employee also as LGS as a Special case considering the long service rendered by the NMRs and keeping in view their long experience in the activities of VUDA and also their age. Further VUDA is ready to bear the additional financial burden also from its own resources in view of their long services rendered to VUDA (for more than 20 years).

The matter is placed before the VUDA Board for orders so as to send necessary proposals to the Government for regularization of the services of above NMRs & contingent employee as LGS as a special case.
