VUDA has loken up development of Master Plan Foods Madhurawada orea in GWAC limits as per the requirement of Ultion providin As a part of the obove it was proposed to widen the easting 24°0° wide road to 10°0° wide from NH-5 in . to Kommadi village in two phases the situate was prepared for the III phase for a length of 1.70KM from NH-5 in 5 with red widening and providing GSB, WMA, Black topping along with central made accordance of two minor Bridges; SW drains on both sides based on 20°0.07 SSR to 8.7790.00 Lakits. Administrative sanction was accorded for Re 7790.01 Lakits.

Meanwhile the local residents of Kommadi surroundings and public representatives have requested to take up the full stretch of road i.e., Phasel & III. Keeping in view of the development activities in the vicinity and growth of Educational institutions etc. Accordingly an Estimate was prepared for balance reach from Suryo Press to Kommadi Village for a length of 1 20km with the components of road widening work proposed are BT Roads, one major & one minor Bridges, Storm water drains on both sides. CO works and certifical median for Rs 202 Lakhs, Administrative sanction was accorded for the phase = If of Rs 202 Lakhs.

The total estimated cost of the road widening from NH-5 to Kommadi Vilage is Rs.1610.00 Lakts (790-820). The 1st phase road work was entrusted through e-tenders and the work is in progress.

Hence, the matteric placed before the VUDA Board for perusal to take up the "Widening of existing road to 100-0" wide Master Rion Road from NH-5 to Choldraya Engineering College via Kommadi, Visokhopotham along with 655, WMM. & No. Construction of C.D.
