AGENDA NOTE:-

It is to submit that, an Eco-friendly organization, the Dolphin Nature Conservation Society, (D.N.C.S) Visakhapatnam has developed and maintained greenery / garden in the R.C.D Hospital, Rehabilitation Centre, Visakhapatnam premises a decade back and the Society put in a letter to the District Collector, Visakhapatnam stating to withdraw the further maintenance of the garden from 02-01-2013 due to its financial crisis.

The District Collection and Chairman, Hospital Development Society suggested to approach the Vice-Chairman, Visakhapatnam Urban Development Authority to take up the exclusive maintenance of the above garden.

Accordingly, the Vice-Chairman, Visakhapatnam Urban Development Authority has inspected the garden and requested the Superintendent, R.C.D Hospital to get approval of the Hospital Development Society to take up further maintenance of the garden by VUDA. The Superintendent, RCD Hospital has given consent to maintain the Garden by VUDA with certain terms and conditions as detailed below:-

- The Visakhapatnam Urban Development Authority has no right on the land or to take up any other development activity except exclusive maintenance of the Gardens.
- 2. The Visakhapatnam Urban Development Authority has to vacate the premises, if the land is required for starting up a paediatric orthopedic Hospital which is pending with the Government.
- 3. Whether the Hospital Development Society or the Director of Medical Education, A.P., Hyderabad feels the necessity of the land for any developmental activity, the VUDA has to shed the maintenance of garden and to vacate the land unconditionally.

Later, the Vice-Chairman, VUDA has constituted the following members of Expert Committee to take up the further development and maintenance of existing Bio-diversity Park by VUDA to finalize the Technical parameters, financial requirement for development and maintenance of RCD Bio-diversity garden.
