AGENDA NOTE:

It is to submit that 48 NMRs & 1 contingent employees are presently working in VUDA in various wings. The details of the various batches of NMRs working as on date in VUDA is as follows:

- 1) 18 NMRs who have completed 5 years of service as on 25-11-1993 as per G.O.Ms.No.212, dt.22-4-1994 and they are eligible for regularization.
- 2) 30 NMRs & 1 contingent employee who have not completed 5 years of service as on the cutoff date i.e. 25-11-1993 as per G.O.Ms.No.212 dt.22-4-1994

The following are the batch of 18 NMRs those who have completed 5 years of service as on 25-11-1993 as per G.O.Ms.No.212 dt.22-4-1994 and are eligible for regularization. The details of 18 NMRs along with date from which they are working in VUDA, the name, age, educational qualification, social status, post to which appointed, date of appointment, are submitted as detailed below:

With respect to the 18 NMRs those who have completed 5 years of service prior to cut off date i.e. on 25-11-1993 as per G.O.Ms.No.212 dt.22-4-1994 ,the proposals are already been sent to Government vide this office letter Rc.No. 1696/78/A3, dated.29-10-2013 requesting the Government to regularize the services of 18 NMRs duly permitting to accommodate and regularize one NMR i.e. Sri.S.Krishna as driver in the existing vacancy and also to sanction supernumerary posts in the cadre of last Grade Services to accommodate and regularize the services of the remaining 17 NMRs in the cadre of last Grade Servants as was done by the Govt. earlier Vide G.O.Ms.No.457 MA, dated.9-10-2002 regularizing the services of 93 NMRs as Last Grade Servants, since no sufficient vacancies are available in the cadre of Chainman / Attender at present , since certain NMRs are going to retire even before their services are regularized. The matter is under examination of the Government and recently vide Letter No.23556/B!/2013-1 dated. 25-11-2013, following remarks were seeked from VUDA.

It is also requested to furnish separate proposals with regard to sanction of supernumerary post.

With respect to the 30 NMRs and 1 contingent employee who have not completed five years of service prior to cut off date i.e. on 25-11-1993 as per G.O.Ms.No.212 dt.22-4-1994, some are technically qualified with degrees like B.E., B.Tech., Polytechnic and ITI and are having experience in VUDA activities. The proposals were already sent to the Government vide this Office letter R.C.No.1696/78/A3 dt.18-8-2013, requesting the Government to regularize the service of 30 NMRs & 1 contingent employee against the existing regular vacancies available in the said cadres on humanitarian grounds, keeping in view of their long experience in the activities of VUDA and their age as a Special case. VUDA is ready to bear the additional financial burden from its own resources, in view of their long services rendered to VUDA for more than 22 years and their requirement in VUDA.

In the meanwhile, certain NMRs working in VUDA has represented vide reference 1st cited, stating that the Municipal Administration & Urban Development Department of Government of A.P. in the G.O. under reference 2nd cited permitted the Commissioner, GVMC, Visakhapatnam to allow minimum time scales to nearly 310 Nos. of NMR'S and other daily wage workers working in GVMC, since they have been working for more than 15 to 18 years. Accordingly the Commissioners, GVMC, Visakhapatnam had allowed the time scale to the NMR / Daily wage workers during 2009 without HRA, and other allowances and not released the annual grade increment as per the instructions stipulated in the said G.O.

Further, stating that the Government have also accorded permission to the Commissioner GVMC, Visakhapatnam vide reference 3rd cited for sanction annual grade increments, HRA and other allowances to the NMR's keeping in view of the orders of the Hon'ble A.P. Tribunal and Hon'ble High Court of A.P. and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on the petitions filed by the NMR's / Daily wage employees. Accordingly, the GVMC, Visakhapatnam has released the annual grade increments, HRA and other allowances and paid the arrears from 2009 to 2013 as per the guidelines in the said G.O.

In view of the above circumstances, the NMR's working in VUDA requested the Vice Chairman, VUDA to allow them the minimum time scale for the post eligible as per their qualifications, since the Government in MA & UD Department has accorded permission to the Commissioner, GVMC to allow minimum time scale to NMRs working in GVMC, as the GVMC and VUDA are part and parcel of the MA & UD Department, on humanitarian grounds keeping in view of their long service rendered for more than 22 years.

Hence, the matter is placed before the VUDA Board to take a decision on the said request to extend minimum time scale and also to sanction increments, HRA, CCA to the NMRS working in VUDA on par with similarly placed cases found in GVMC.
