AGENDA NOTE

The WUDA Board in its Resolution No. 423 dt. 26.12.93 has resolved to adopt the T.A.Rules and the rates as fixed by the Government in G.O.Ms. No.252 dt. 15.6.93 and G.O.Ms.No.249 dt. 11.6.93. The following are the provisions of the subsequent G.O.Ms.No.124 dt. 21.8.99 of Fin. & Plg. Dept. in so far as they relate to re-imbursement of lodging charges.

In case lodging charges are re-imbursed, the D.A. hall be reduced by 25%.

The above rates are applicable to Government Servants visiting Visakhapatnam, Vijayawada, Tirupathi, Warangal from outside the district concerned and Hyderabad from any place.

It is a fact that the lodging charges in the above Cities is very much higher especially in Hyderabad than what is being re-imbursed as per the T.A.Bules. As a result each employee is loosing substantial amount whenever they go on tour to Hyderabad on office work. Hence, the increase in the re-imbursement of lodging charges needs consideration to over come this loss. It is also ascertained from HUDA, Hyderabad that higher lodging chargor actuals are paid by HUDA in some cases after obtaining specific approval of the Vice Chairman.

In view of the above position, it will be justifiable to consider the following cailings for re-imbursement of lodging charges and conveyance charges subject to production of Lodge receipts, in so far it relates to Hyderabad and outside the State as per the T.A.Rules of Central Government Employees.

For journey by own Car/Taxi Rs.8.00/KM For journey by Autorickshaw/Dwn Scooter Rs.4.00/KM

For travel between Airport/Railway Station/Bus Station and residence in Metropolitan Cities of Delhi, Mumbai, Calcutta and Chennai taxi fare prescribed by Directorate of Transport * 25% thereon or the actual fare paid whichever is less.

Where the actual expenditure incurred towards lodging charges is lesser, it can be limited to the actual lodging charges subject to the maximum as indicated above.
