SUB:- VUDA – ACCOUNTS – Release of Medical Aid to Sri M.Appanna, Dy.E.E. for undergoing surgery of “PERI AMPULLAR TUMOUR’ – Ratification –Reg.

AGENDA NOTE

Sri M Appanna, Deputy Executive Engineer, VUDA in his letter dt. 24.10.2003 has submitted that as per the advise of the Doctor at Care Hospital, Visakhapatnam, he is undergoing surgery of “PERI AMPULLAR TUMOUR” at Care Hospital, Visakhapatnam and hence requested to grant medical aid as per rules to meet the expenditure.

The matter has been examined in detail. Government in G.O. Ms. No.58 Health, Medical and Family Welfare (K1) Department dt. 1.3.2002 have enhanced the maximum ceiling to Rs. 1,00,000/- for re-imburement of medical expenses for the treatment of by pass surgery, kidney transplantation, Cancer & Neuro surgery in respect of serving employees and their dependents.

Government in G.O. Ms. No.175 dt. 29.5.97 have issued instructions that when treatment has been undergone in private recognized hospitals in cases of urgency without referred letter, a 20% cut has to be imposed on the eligible amount after getting the bills scrutinized by the Director of Medical Education, Hyderabad.

In view of the above G.Os the request of the individual was considered and he was paid Rs. 80,000/- as medical advance for his operation (for Cancer) at CARE Hospital, Visakhapatnam.

As he has availed the Medical Advance / re-imburement facility as per the Government rules in force, he will be covered by those rules only and will not receive any medical allowance ie one month basic pay per year which is in vogue in VUDA in future

The matter is placed before the VUDA Board for its ratification.
