Sub:- VUDA – ACCOUNTS – Release of Medical Aid repayable without interest in favour of Sri G.Sundara Rao, S/D'man to meet medical expenses in connection with his fracture leg – from part final withdrawal of PF accumulations as per his future entitlement – Reg.

AGENDA NOTE

Sri G.Sundara Rao, S/D'man has requested for medical re-imburement of Rs. 50,000/- as he is met with accident on 19.4.2002 while returning from his official outdoor duties.

The matter was examined in detail as per Government medical rules, he is not entitled for medical re-imburement for his ailment. Hence, he was sanctioned discretionary advance of Rs. 50,000/- carrying interest @ 6% per annum to meet medical expenses of his fracture of left leg.

But the individual in his application dt. 4.10.2003 has informed that his left leg was fractured due to accident in which he was seriously injured and he has taken a treatment in a private hospital and spent Rs. 2.00 lakhs for surgery for 2 times due to diabetic and hence requested to sanction medical aid as in the case of other employees who met with accident on official duties.

The matter has been re-examined in detail with reference to the GPF rules under condition No.15(C). As per this condition the individual is entitled for P.F. part withdrawal upto 3/4th of his accumulations as a Special Case. Hence, it has been considered to sanction an amount of Rs. 50,000/- to Sri Sundara Rao, S/D'man with the following conditions.

- 1 The amount will be released in two instalments @ Rs. 25,000/- every alternative month as medical aid repayable without interest from part and final withdrawal of P.F. accumulation as per his future entitlement.
- 2 Accordingly, the 1st instalment and 2nd instalments each Rs. 25,000/- have been paid to the individual in the month of October and December
- 3 The total amount of Rs. 50,000/- sanctioned as medical aid to the individual will be deducted from his future PF accumulations as per his entitlement i.e., when his PF accumulations reach to Rs. 67,000/- the amount of Rs. 50,000/- will be deducted and adjusted to VUDA funds.

The matter is placed before VUDA Board for its ratification.
