AGENDA NOTE

While enclosing the representation of Sri Dronamroju Srinivasa Rao, MLA, Visakhapatnam (South) dated 22.1.2008, through CMP No. 1848/CMP/2009 dated 16.07.2009, the Joint Secretary to Government, M.A & U.D. Department, A.P. Secretariat, Hyderabad requested Vice Chairman, VUDA to examine the issue and take necessary action under intimation to the Government vide letter No. 11847/TC/2/2009 -dat. 24.7.2009.

In the said representation Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh was requested to recommend extending a financial help of Rs. 3.00 Crores for taking up restoration works to Temple of learning i.e. Mrs. A.V.N. College.

Thereupon Vice Chairman, VUDA instructed to consult Sri Dronamroju Srinivasa Rao, MLA., Visakhapatnam (South) and the Principal of the College and identify suitable works to be taken up by VUDA and submit a report in the matter.

Later on consultation with the said MLA and Principal of the College, list of works proposed amounting to Rs. 3.00 Crores along with copy of estimation prepared by the architect have furnished and requested to take up all the works by VUDA.


Since this subject comes under Hon'ble Chief Minister's Assurance, it is proposed to take up the same in a phased manner. Accordingly, Vice Chairman, VUDA has accorded administrative sanction for Rs. 1.05 Crores to take up the following works initially.

1. Construction of Library block between quadrangle and existing Library building extension of Ground Floor & First Floor.
2. Construction of 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Floors of Women's Hostel.

Hence, the matter is placed before VUDA Board for kind perusal and ratification.
