## SUBJECT NO 84

Sub:- VUDA- Visakhapatnam- Accounts- Walver of balance HBA of late Smt P. Sarada, SA-Rea. 666

Smt P. Sarada, SA. VUDA has expired while in service on 18.07.2008, after rendering a total service of 25years, 6months & 18days.

The pension proposals were sent to the State Audit. Visakhapatnam and the State Audit Department has verified and certified the pension proposals as detailed below.

- Rs. 1.31.134/-Gratuity

- Rs. 5.143/- to her son for a period Family Pension from 19.7,2008 to 23.8,2009

In this connection it is submitted that the following amounts to tune of Rs. 4.42,109/- are to be recovered from the pensinary benefits of late P. Sarada, SA.

> Out standing loan of HUDCO 1.23.847 Niwas with interest as on 31.05.09. 12.052 CO-operative loan Outstanding Discretionary Joan (Principal amount sanctioned by VUDA 89,000 HBA with interest sanctioned by VUDA 1.98.210 19,000

Interest on discretionary loan

HUDCO loan and Discretionary loan sanctioned by VUDA were adjusted from out of the amounts drawn from her leave encashment and GSLIS Death claim.

Still an amount of Rs. 2.17.210/- towards HBA and Interest on discretionary loan is to be recovered from the Grafuity and P.F. amount of Rs. 1,31,134 + 58,041= 1,89,175/-.

But the pensionary benefits are not sufficient to adjust the entire due amount and there is a deficit of Rs, 28,035/- towards HBA.

Sri P. Hemanth Kumar S/o Late P. Sarada, SA has requested for wavier of the HBA Loan as he is an un-employee and he is not in a position to pay the amounts. But later he was appointed as Junior Assistant in VUDA on compassionate grounds with effect from 21.08.2009

In this regard it is submitted that as per Go Ms No 212 Finance & planning dt 20.4.77 and Go Ms No 171 Finance & Planning dt 04.07.1976 and Go Ms No 401 Finance & planning ff 94.40L) dt 14.11.1990, the competent Authority who sanctioned the HBA / Loan is competent to write off the balance loan and interest due from the employee who died while in service including AI India officers.

Earlier in the case of M. Rama Roo, Attender who expired while in service on 11.07.2003, the balance of hause cost to a tune of 81.10.5044/- was waived totally as a special case interms of Go Ms No 401, Finance & Planning at 14.11.1990, vide VUDA Resolution No 136 dt 28.07.2003, and recently in the case of G. veeru naidu. Chainman, who expired while in service on 12.10.2007, the balance of HBA was waived to a tune of 81. 53.7127- after adjusting at the persionary benefits vide Proceedings Rc No 822/07/K7 at 21.5.2008 subject to ratification by the Board.

Though some employees were died while in service, the pensionary benefits were sufficient to adjust the loans / recoveries, but in this case the recoveries are more than the pensionary benefits.

In view of the above position the matter has been examined in detail and considered to waive the balance of HBA after adjusting all the benefits forwards the dues and to place the matter before Board for ratification. Accordingly the balance of HBA amounting to 83, 28,035/+ was waived after adjusting 83, 1,89,175/-.

Hence the matter is placed before VUDA Board for perusal and ratification.
