AGENDA NOTE :

In order to establish truck terminal, the District Collector, Visakhapatnam convened a meeting on 16.03.1993. The Commissioner of Police, Vice-Chairman, VUDA, Joint Collector, Asst. Transport Commissioner, Officials of Visakhapatnam Steel Plant, HPCL, Indian Oil Corporation have attended the meeting. The truck terminal is very much required along the N.H-5 nor the Steel Plant, and other industrial areas since large number of trucks are being parked on the both sides of the N.H. The facilities for truck parking i.e. rest houses, petrol service station, Automobile sheds, and godowns are required. In the meeting it has been decided to request the Visakhapatnam Steel Plant to allot 22 acres of land to V.U.D.A. at a nominal cost for setting up a truck terminal as a commercial project abutting N.H.-5. The Steel Plant authorities have promised that they would take up the matter with the Ministry to obtain necessary clearance. Hence, the V.U.D.A. Board may consider giving their willingness to start as commercial project if the land is given to V.U.D.A. by Steel Plant/ Government to take up Truck Terminal Project.
