Sub:- Establishment - VUDA - Régularisation of
NMRS - Extending the Service benefits - Reg.

The VUDA earlier engaged the services of N.M.Rs in the Engineering works as well as maintenance of VUDA parks. The Govt. was requested to issue orders with regard to regularisation of N.M.R Services in VUDA. The Govt. in its letter No. 245/B1/89-1, M.A. dt. 4-2-89 directed the VUDA to examine all the cases of N.M.Rs proposed for regularisation in terms of G.O.Ms.No. 1320/M.A. dt. 15-12-87.

Accordingly, 144 N.M.Rs who have completed 5 years of service were regularised vide Proceedings dt. 4-2-89 1-2-90, 6-2-90 and 1-6-92. The Board in its resolution No. 115, dt. 17-6-92 ratified the action of the Vice-Chairman, the regularising the 144 N.M.R services.

Out of 144 regularised N.M.Rs 38 N.M.Rs were absorbed in the lower cadres in various Wings of VUDA basing on their educational qualifications against the resultant vacancies, 3 N.M.Rs deceased and 3 N.M.Rs absconded from service. At present (144-44) 100 regularised N.M.Rs are in existence.

The N.M.Rs who were put in time scale have requested to extend the benefits to them on par with the regular employees. After examining the above issue, the then Vice-Chairman issued orders extending the following benefits to the Regular N.M.Rs of VUDA on par with the regular Employees vide proceedings Rc.No. 1696/C/78/A7, dt. 4-10-94, with effect from 1-10-94, subject to ratification by the Board and the Government.

1. Leave
2. Medical
3. Reimbursement of Bus pass
