Sub:- WDA - Accounts Wing - Sanction of Discretionary Loan in favour of certain employees - Reg.

AGENDA NOTE

The following employees working in WDA have applied for sanction of Discretionary Loan on Medical grounds in their favour as follows:

1. Sri P. Veeraraju, Driver

He states that his mother is not feeling well and she is suffering with long ailment. The doctor advised her for constant treatment with medicines. Thereby he has requested this office to sanction a loan amount of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) being Discretionary Loan for incurring medical expenditure of his old mother who is fully dependent on him. He has also submitted the medical certificate issued by Dr. D. Venkateswara Rao, M.S.

2. Smt. K. Vidyavathi, S/D'man

She has submitted that she is suffering from Feloid ceteron since a long period for which Doctor has advised her for operation. She has further stated that an amount of Rs.15,000/- to Rs.20,000/- shall have to be incurred towards operation charges. A medical certificate to that effect is also furnished. She has therefore requested WUDA to sanction an amount of Rs.20,000/- towards Discretionary Loan as she is unable to incur such huge expenditure from her salary.

Previously in case of Sri S. Surya Rao, Dafedar to Chairman, WUDA was sanctioned an amount of Rs.30,000/- towards Discretionary Advance vide Resolution No.220 dt. 21.10.92 as a special case.

Hence, the request of the above two individuals may be considered for sanction of Discretionary advance in favour of Sri P. Veeraraju, Driver for Rs.25,000/- and Rs.20,000/- in favour of Smt. K. Vidyavathi, S/D'man as per request made by them. The recovery of principal amount may be made in 72 monthly instalments and interest at 12% in 24 monthly instalments.

The matter is placed before WDA Board for its approval.
