AGENDA NOTE :

The following individuals who are the wives of the deceased WUDA employees have represented to sanction Pension and Gratuity to them, since the WUDA has provided compassionate employment to them only and not sanctioned so far the pensionary benefits to them.

In the above three cases, the WUDA has provided compassionate appointments to the wives in the first two cases and to the son in the 3rd case. Smt. P. Sitaratnam and Smt. J. Pydithalli, Attenders have stated that they have not received the gratuity so far. Smt. S. Ammaji W/o late Sri S. A. N. Raju had received gratuity amount of Rs. 12,150/-.
