Sub : Establishment - VUDA - Vsp. - Regularisation of the Services of Certain NMRs working in VUDA - Reg.

## AGENDA NOTE:

Presently there are 66 NMRs working in VUDA for a long period ranging from 10 to 15 years except 3 NMRs who were appointed on compassionate grounds as detailed in the statement. Out of the above 66 NMRs, 39 NMRs are having Technical Qualification such as Engineering graduates, Diploma Holders, ITI Certificate holders etc. The remaining 27 NMRs are having academic qualification from graduation and below. The services of the above NMRs are being utilized in different Projects / Housing Schemes / Engineering Civil Works, VUDA Parks etc which are necessary and essential for the organization. They are being paid daily wages as fixed by the District Collector, Visakhapatnam from time to time. A statement showing the details like Name, age, education, date of Joining and placement of above 66 NMRs is submitted for kind perusal.

The Government have observed that the appointing authority of the state Governments, have appointed persons to various categories of services either on daily wages or on temporary basis without there being a post with a view to regularize as many as NMR / Daily wage employees as possible who are otherwise qualified and also keeping in view of the hardship they would be cause, if their services are not regularized and also keeping in view of the Judgement dt. 12-8-1992 of the Hon'ble Supreme court in civil appeal the Government have formulated a scheme for regularization of services of the persons who are appointed on daily wage basis. Accordingly the Government in GO.Ms. No. 212 ( F \& P ) dt. 22-4-1994 have issued orders that the services of that persons who worked continuously for period of five years and are continuing as on 25-11-1993 be regularized subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

1) the persons appointed should possess the qualification as per rules in force as on the date from which his / her scrvices have to be regularized.
2) They should be within the age limits as on the date of appointment as NMR / Daily wage employee.
3) The rule of reservation wherever applicable will be followed and backlog will be set off against future vacancies.
4) Sponsoring of candidates from employment Exchange is relaxed.
5) Absorption shall be against clear vacancies of posts considered necessary to be continued as per work load excluding the vacancies already notified to the A.P. Public Services Commission / District Selection Committee.
6) In the case of work charged Establishment, where there will be no clear vacancies, because of the fact that the expenditure on workcharged is at a fixed percentage of P.S. Charges and as soon as the work is over, the services of workcharged Establishment will have to be terminated, they shall be adjusted in the other Departments, District Offices provided there are clear vacancies of Last Grade Servants.

The services of these 66 NMRs were not regularized and not absorbed into regular services due to the instructions issucd by the Government in GO Ms.No. 212 dt . 22-4-1994 directing absorption can be done only on the availability of sanctioned posts and completion of 5 years of service as on 25-11-1993 and complying the other requirements as laid down in the said GO.

The VUDA Board in its Resolution No. 509, dt. 21-2-2000 has resolved to recommend to Government for regularization of the services of 39 NMRs who are having Technical qualifications. Accordingly the Government were requested in this office letter Rc.No. 1696 / 78-A3 dt. 28-3-2001 to issue necessary orders for regularization of 39 Technical NMRs as Technical work inspectors as they are having necessary Technical qualifications required for the posts.

On this the Government have requested certain clarifications in the above matter. The information called for by the Government was sent to the Government vide this office Lr. RC. No. 1696 / 78 - A3, Dt. 18-2-2003. But no orders have been received from the Government in the above matter so far.

The Government in GO. MS. No. 457 MA dt. 9-10-2002 have issued orders ratifying the action of Vice Chairman in regularization of the services of 93 RNMRs and extending the benefits on par with regular employees of VUDA treating them as regular cmployees.

In view of the above circumstances as these 66 NMRs are working in VUDA for a long time ranging from 10 to 15 years (except 3 Compassionate appointment made in 1994 at the Serial No. 64,65 \& 66 in the statement) and the services of these NMRs are required and essential for various projects being under taken by VUDA. In addition to this the VUDA is meeting the expenditure on these NMRs from its own resources for all
own resources for all these years by engaging on the VUDA projects. Now the VUDA is taking up so many Mega Projects, Tourism development projects, Housing Projects and the services are further required, and the VUDA can also bear expenditure by charging to the respective projects. The VUDA is also having sufficient resources to meet the expenditure on regularization of the services of the above 66 NMRs.

The Hon'ble Chairman has instructed to place the matter before Board for taking a decision in the above matter. Hence Draft Subject place before VUDA Board for taking a decision for regularization of the services of 66 NMRs duly treating them as LGS and extend the benefits on par with VUDA regular employees as was done in the case of 93 RNMRs whose services were regularized and the benefits extended vide GO.Ms. No. 457 MA dt. 9-10-2002.

) Out of 66 NMR's, 3 NMR's at SI.Nos. $64,65 \& 66$ are originally appointed as NMR's during the year 1994 on compassionate grounds. Later as per the Government orders the individuals were terminated from the services on the plea that the compassionate appointments does not apply to NMR's vice proceedings Rc.No. $7657 / 94-\mathrm{A} 3 \mathrm{dt}$ 26-5-1997, Subsequently these 3 NMR's approached the A.P.A.T. As per the A.P.A.T orders and in pursuance of orders of the Supreme Court of India dt. 18-1-2000, the individuals were reappointed as NMR's vide proceedings Rc. No. $7657 / 94-\mathrm{A} 3 \mathrm{dt}$. $19-2-2000$. They reported to duty on 21-2-2000 as.NMR's.
In view of the above it is submitted that the total services of the 3 individuals is 10 years out of this 10 years of service there is break of service from $26-5-$ 1997 to 19-2-2000 ( 2 years 2 months ), in view of the reasons stated above.
As regards SI.No. 53 to 63 there is some ambiguity in respect of Dates of Joining in view of joining and termination and taking back them into VUDA services as per Court directions etc.
