- 2) Smt. J. Pydithalli, : Attender
 W/e.late Sri J. (Cempassionate appointment).
 Appala Reddy.
- 3) Smt. S.Ammaji, : Her sen Sri S.Chinna appeinted W/e.late Sri S.A.N.Raju. as Chainman en compassionate grounds.

Gratuity sanctioned Rs.12,150/earlier.

In the above three eases, the Visakhapatnam Urban Development Authority has provided compassionate appointments to the Wives on the first two eases and to the son in the third ease. Smt. P.Sita Ratnam & Smt. J.Pydithalli, Attenders have stated that they have not received the gratuity so far. Smt. S.Ammaji, W/o.late Sri S.A.N.Raju had received gratuity amount of Rs.12,150/-.

The above 3 individuals expired while in service and they have expired prior to the issue of G.O. by Government extending the Pensionary benefits to all the employees of the Urban Development Authorities in the State on par with the State Government employees in G.O.Ms.Na.631, M.A., dated 13.12.1991. Hence, the Pensionary benefits have not been given to them, previously since they expired prior to the issuance of above said G.O.

In this connection, it is, brought to the natice of the VUDA Board that on a request made by VUDA (after approval by VUDA in VUDA Board Resolution No.144, dated 21.37.1392) to extend the Ponsionary benefits accorded in G.O.Ms.No.631, M.A., dated 13.12.1391 to the 2 deceased employees, the Government have extended the family pension benefits to the families of late Sri G.Ramakrishna, Admn.
