Sub:- Establishment - VUDA, Vsp. Regularisation of persons appointed on daily wages/NMRs or consolidated pay-Reg.

Under provisions of G.O.Ms.1320 MA, dt.15-12-81, the V.U.D.A. has regularised the services of 144 NMRs from 1-2-90 who have completed 5 years of service and placed them in the minimum of the time scale of Rs.740-1150 ie., the last grade servants scale irrespective of their category or qualifications they belongs to. The same was approved and ratified by the VUDA Board in its resolution No.115, dt.17.6.92. Though they were put in the time scale they are not being sanctioned periodical increments, leaves and other benefits on par with regular employees.

In this Office letter Rc.No.1696/78 A2, dt.18-9-93 the Govt. were addressed to ratify the action taken in having regularised the services of 144 NMRs and put them in the time scale of Rs.740-1150, and to create posts for all the regularised NMRs as per the G.O.Ms.No.1320 M.A.Dt.15.12.81 and extend all the benefits on par with the regular employees. The Orders of the Govt., are still awaited in the matter.

Out of the 144 NMRs whose services are regularised, 43 NMRs have been absorbed in the sanctioned posts like Asst.Engineers, D'Man, S/D'man, Jr.Assts. Typists, Work Inspectors grade-III as per their eligibility for the posts.

In G.O.Ms.No.212 Finance and planning dated 22-4-94 the Government have issued instructions for regularisation and absorption of the persons working on Daily wage N.M.R. or consolidated pay who have completed 5 years of service and are continuing as on 25.11.93 subject to fulfilment of certain conditions.

One of the conditions stipulated in the G.O. is that " the absorption shall be against clear vacancies of posts considered necessary to be continued as per work load excluding the vacancies already notified to the Andhra Pradesh public service Commission/District Selection Committee."

In addition to the above acquisition proposals, it is ¹¹⁹ now proposed to acquire the following private lands measuring Ac.45.06 in Anandapuram and Vemulavalasa Villages for Truck terminals at Anandapuram junction which would be a greater importance and need to the city and its passing traffic. Further, the above lands are earmarked for truck terminal in the sanctioned Master plan.

The above position was informed to the Collector, Visakhapatnam, L.A.O., VUDA., in this office Lr.Dt.19.6.95 requesting to take further action for withdrawal of the lands in Sangivalasa and Kummariipalem Villages., Pending approvals of VUDA Board, in view of urgency.

In view of the above position the VUDA Board is requested to approve the following proposals.

1. To ratify the action in having requested the Collector, Visakhapatnam and L.A.O., VUDA to withdraw the lands measuring Ac.94.03 in Sangivalasa (V) and Ac.166.78 in Kummariipalem (V) from acquisition proceedings of VUDA pending approval of VUDA Board.
2. To confine the L.A., in favour of UDA for an extent of Ac.17.30 in Sangivalasa (V) and Ac.34.66 in Kummariipalem (V).
3. To acquire private lands measuring Ac.18.98 and Ac.26.08 in Anandapuram and Vemulavalasa (V) respectively for Truck Terminal at Anandapuram junction.
