SJB:- PLAINING - V.U.D.A. - Installation of 50 HP Stone crusher in S.No.245/1 of Rebaka (v) applied by Sri Ch.Eswara Rao, Proprietor of M/s.Chama Brothers Stone Crusher - Reg.

AGENDA NOTE :

Sri Ch.Eswara Rao, Proprietor of M/s.Chama Brothers Stone Crusher has submitted a change of land-use application from Agricultural to Industrial use in S.No.245/1p Rebaka village of Anakapalle Mandal for installation of 50 H.P.Stone crusher.

As per the sanctioned Master Plan, the site falls in agricultural land-use and abutting to 30' B.T. Road leading to Mattur and Chintanippula Agraharam village.

Earlier, V.U.D.A. has approved in its Resolution No.62, dated 09.04.1992 change of land-use proposal to issue two years temporary permission to M/s.Marathi Stone Crusher and M/s.Venkata Sasi Stone Crusher in S.No.245/p, 246/2 & 247 of Rebaka village and also to recommend to Government for change of land-use from Agricultural to ~~Residential~~ Industrial.

The Government after examining the proposal has issued order confirming the change of land-use in S.No.245, 245/2 & 247 of Rebaka village vide G.O.Ms.No. M.A., dated 05.10.1993.

Subsequently M/s.Chama Brothers Stone Crushing Unit has submitted a change of land-use proposal in S.No.245/1 of Rebaka village for an extent of Ac.1.00 for installation of one more stone crusher. The present change of land-use site is adjacent to the already permitted two stone crushers site.

The party has paid an amount of Rs.15,138/- to V.U.D.A. towards development charges.

The party has produced the following documents :

- a) No Objection certificate from A.P.Pollution Control Board.
- b) S.S.I. Unit Certificate from General Manager, District Industries Centre, Visakhapatnam.

- c) Feasibility certificate from Anakapalle Rural Electric Cooperative Society to supply Power to run 50 H.P. Stone Crusher.
- d) District Medical & Health Officer's approval.
- e) Quarry lease certificate issued by Deputy Director, Mines & Geology Department.

In view of the above, since the Government has already confirmed the land-use proposal for the two stone crushers in S.Nos. 245, 246/2 & 247 of Rebaka village, the V.U.D.A. is requested to approve this change of land-use proposal in S.No. 245/1 for an extent of Ac. 1.00 for forwarding it to the Government for consideration.
