SUB:- Accounts - VUDA Vsp. - Sanction of Special Discretionary Advance in favour of Sri A. Nageswara Rao, Jr. Asst. VUDA - Reg.

Sri A. Nageswara Rao, Jr. Assistant, VUDA in his representation has requested for sanction of Special Discretionary Advance of Rs. 30,000/- to meet urgent Medical expenses of his son who is suffering with bleeding disorder. The application of the individual has been examined in detail and the following observation made in this regard.

Sri A. Nageswara Rao, Junior Assistant, VUDA Son is suffering with bleeding disorder. Which is dreadful disease. For every injury wound or such an incident, the child requires blood transfusion. The medical certificates given by Doctor reveals that the investigations available in the city are not adequate and available in major medical institutions like Madras & Vellur and suggested immediate treatment at vellur. Previously in a similar case the VUDA inits R.No. 283 dt. 4.1.93 has sanctioned a sum of Rs. 33,750/- to Sri B. U. S. Subrahmanya, Sr. Asst. VUDA.

Hence sanction was accorded for payment of Rs. 30,000/- to Sri A. Nageswara Rao, Jr. Asst. VUDA towards Medical expenses of his son subject to the following conditions.



1. That the amount shall be recovered from the salary of the individual in 70 monthly instalment commencing from 2/94.
2. That the interest at 6% p.a. shall be recovered in 10 monthly instalment after completion of recovery amount.
3. That the individual has to produce necessary surity bond for himself and also from another employee not below his rank.
4. The amount will be released in instalments at the first instance a sum of Rs. 10,000/- is released on hearing from the Hospital Authorities (estimate expenses) the rest of the amount will be released.

Hence the matter is placed before VUDA for ratification of the action taken in having sanctioned a sum of Rs. 30,000/- to Sri A.Nageswara Rao, Junior Assistant, VUDA for under taking immediate treatment to his son who is suffering from bleeding disorder in anticipation of the approval of VUDA Board.
